## Lesson Plan

1. Benchmark, Objective, Essential Question, Homelearning and Exit ticket filled out and connected to the lesson. ( $\mathbf{1 0} \mathbf{~ p t s . )}$
2. Bellringer: choose a problem to practice prior knowledge that helps the student with the new concept. ( $\mathbf{1 0}$ pts.)
3. Whole Group: The example and explanation properly cover the objective of the selected topic for the lesson. ( $\mathbf{1 0} \mathbf{~ p t s . )}$
4. Practice: short effective practice (provided in an attached document with actual questions and an answer key). (10 pts.)

## Instruction

1. Bellringer: Teacher starts by solving one problem with the students on the board to practice prior knowledge. Teacher may ask a student to do the problem and/ or explain it to the rest of the class. (10 pts.)
2. Teacher presents the objective of the lesson and introduces the topic. ( $\mathbf{1 0}$ pts.)
3. Whole Group: Teacher effectively explains the concept to the class and shares an example modeling step by step solution. ( $\mathbf{2 0} \mathbf{~ p t s . )}$
4. Practice: short effective practice (provided in an attached document with actual questions and an answer key). (10 pts.)
